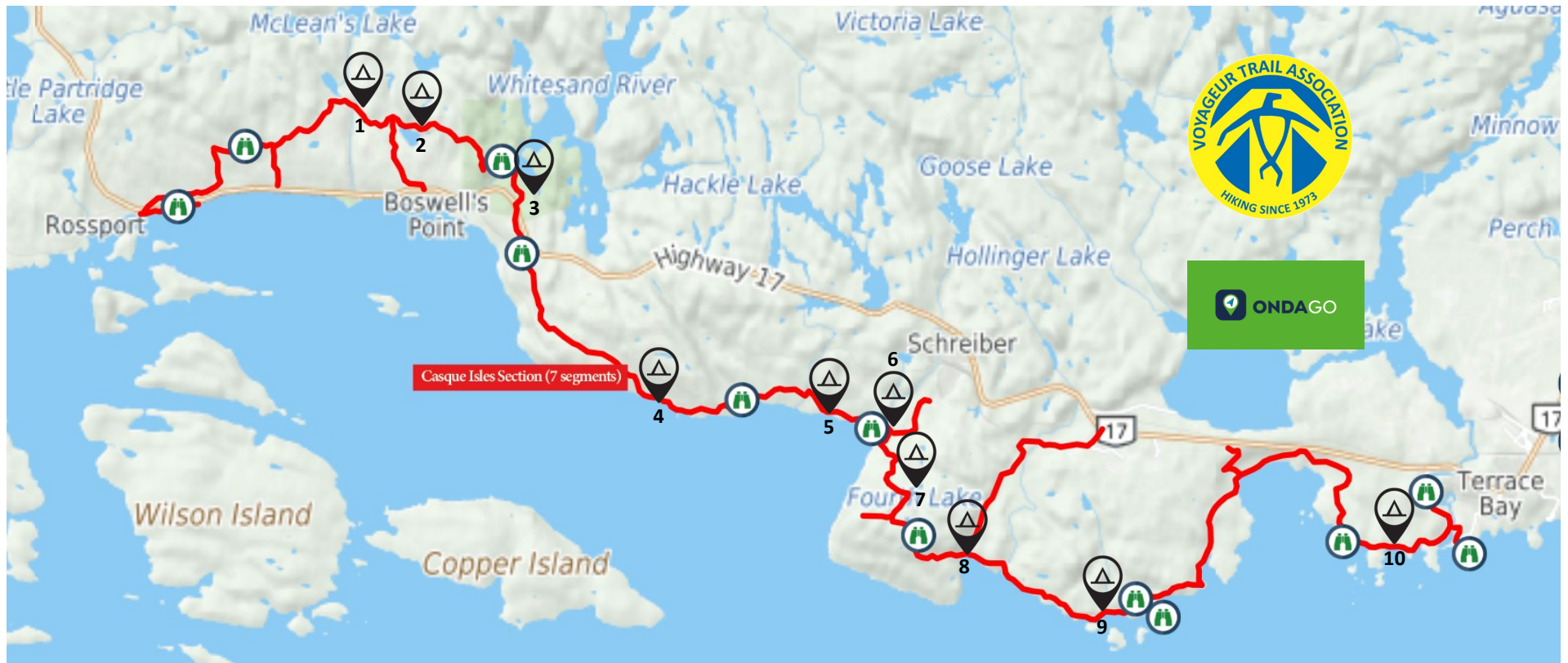


Casque Isles Trail Campsite Information



All campsites are first come—first served. There is not a reservation system for campsites along the trail.

If you have to share a site, be considerate to others.

Remember, if you can carry it in, then you can carry it out! Do not dispose of garbage in the fire pits or bear boxes.

Not only are you leaving your trash behind for someone else to carry out, garbage will draw bears to the area.

Think of your fellow hikers who will come behind you!

Extinguish any fires with water until they are cold. Occasionally there will be Fire Bans in the area, consult the authorities before your hike or contact the Club at casqueisles@gmail.com.

Obey any Fire Ban or restrictions, this is our backyard and we wouldn't want any user to be responsible for a wild fire.

1. Mcleans Creek	✓	✓	✓	✓	Creek flowing nearby.	Wooded inland site, cell coverage spotty. Can fit 3 small tents.
2. Pond @ KM 9	✓	✓	✓	✓	Pond, may require wading.	Wooded inland site. Can fit 2 or 3 small tents.
3. Rainbow Falls Prov. Park Whitesand Campground		✓	✓	Outhouses & Comfort Station.	Lake water or taps in campgrounds.	Provincial Park, sites may need to be reserved. Proceed to Gatehouse to register. When Campgrounds are closed, no camping allowed.
4. Twin Harbours	✓	✓	✓	✓	Lake Superior.	Sand beach on Lake Superior, very picturesque. Thunder box is found near trail west of site. Can fit 4 or 5 small tents.
5. KM 26	✓	✓	✓	✓	Lake Superior.	Small and larger stone beach on Lake Superior. A very nice site. Can fit 2 or 3 small tents.
6. Schreiber Beach	✓	✓		Outhouse.	Lake Superior.	Large sand and pebble beach on Lake Superior. Gazebo for cover. Camping is allowed on the beach, and between brick pillars found near gazebo, the remainder is private property. Can fit many tents. Town beach, public access.
7. Fourth Lake	✓	✓	✓	✓	Fourth Lake.	Wooded inland site, very pretty. Can fit 4 small tents. Thunder box can be found near trail passing site.
8. Worthington Bay		✓	✓	✓	Lake Superior.	Large sand and pebble beach on Lake Superior. Can fit many tents. No cell coverage at site. ATV and 4x4 access, public access.
9. Les Petits Ecrits	✓	✓	✓	✓	Lake Superior.	Small sand beach that is different every year due to creek flowing through it. Thunder box is found near the trail to the west. Very nice site. Can fit 5 tents.
10. Lyda Bay		✓			Lake Superior.	Large sand beach, can fit many tents. Minimal amenities, site is in the Terrace Bay Nature Reserve.
